The institution has been extending higher education to remote and backward regions, integrating professional ethics, gender equality, human values, environment, and sustainability into the curriculum through various organized activities.

Professional Ethics and Human Values: The institution hosts activities such as commemorations of eminent personalities, Yoga Day, Blood Donation Camps, COVID-19 awareness campaigns, etc.

Gender Sensitivity and Equality:

- 1. Legal advisors, doctors, and psychologists are periodically invited to provide guidance to students.
- 2. International Women's Day is annually observed.
- 3. To facilitate the reporting of concerns and suggestions, a complaint box is installed on campus, promoting a written approach to address issues and prevent disturbances.
